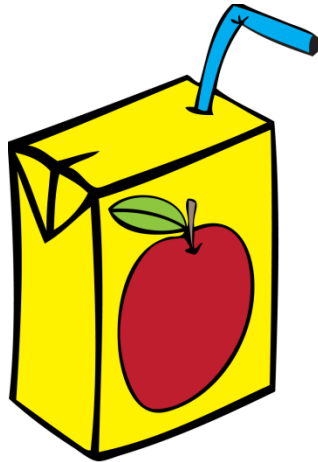

Welcome Home Landmark

On Friday, October 14th, Justin & Germaine and their 4 children moved to Rutland Street between St. Vincent & Cottman, then, a couple hours later, Asukulu, Angoya, and Kakozi moved into Welcome Home. Asukulu, Angoya, and Kakozi make up the **50th** family to move into Welcome Home! We have helped 154 individuals from 12 nationalities with housing since Welcome Home started in 2012. Thank you for welcoming the stranger as Jesus calls us to do!



The Guiding Coalition at Prince of Peace developed 7 SMART Goals since Easter. In brief they are:

1. Be prepared to welcome 600 unaccompanied minors if they arrive at the Navy Depot
2. Behavioral Cultural Change Project, so adults learn how to show the children mutual respect & good behavior
3. Research starting a Day Care at POP (4 leaders needed)
4. Use percussion instruments on the 1st Sunday of every month
5. LifeGroup Bible Study, Thursday evenings at Lawndale Court (We learned "Good things happen when you leave the office.")
6. Hold & Advertise a special community event every 3 months
7. Prepare for a Consecration Sunday (4 leaders needed to lead 6 small group discussions on Stewardship)
